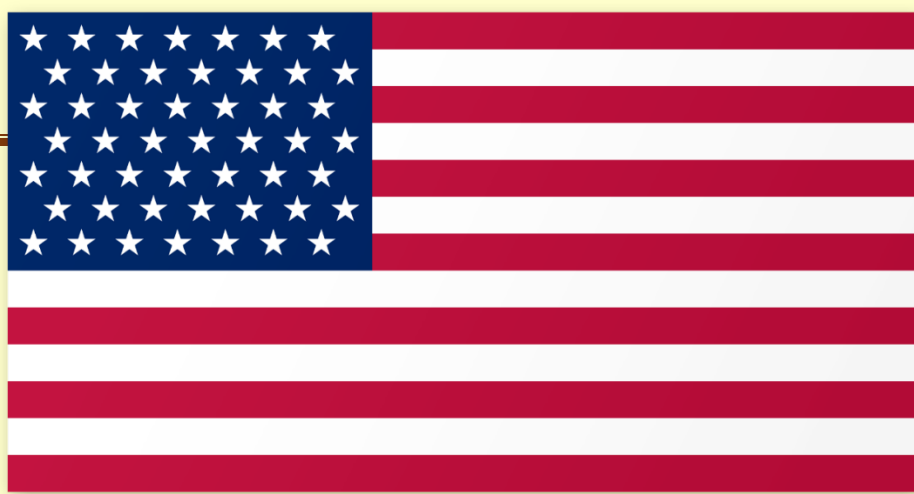

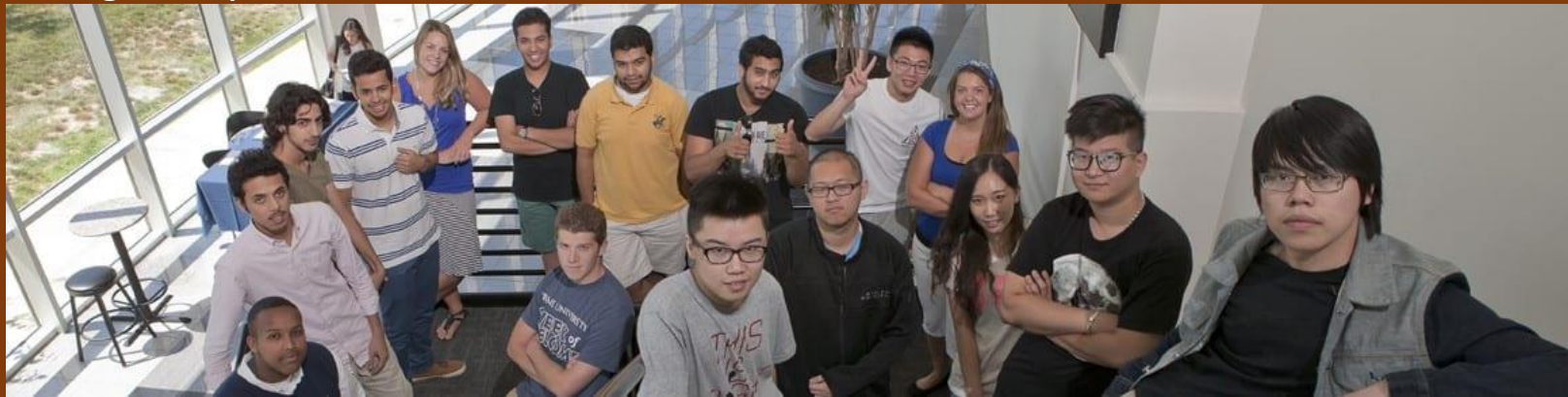

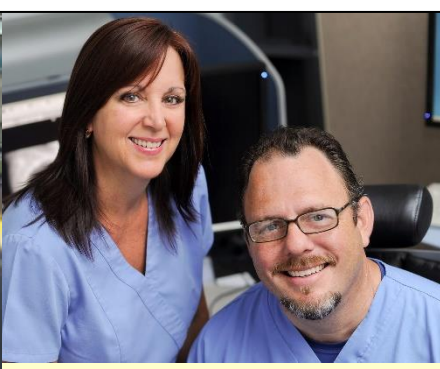

Location of Florida

Florida is a State located in the Southeastern region of the Southern United States of America (USA). With a population of over 21 million, Florida is the 22nd-most extensive of the 50 United States. The State of Florida is bordered to the west by the Gulf of Mexico, to the northwest by Alabama State, to the north by Georgia, to the east by the Atlantic Ocean, and to the south by the Straits of Florida situated in the south-eastern region of the country. The Capital city of Florida is Tallahassee. Many outsiders know of the State of Florida because of its citrus Agriculture and amusement parks. With its considerable large population and economy, this low-lying State has quite a lot.

Florida Life and Culture

The culture of Florida is similar to the rest of the American Southern culture in the panhandle region, but as a coastal State historically characterized by immigration, south Florida's urban culture has been influenced by immigration populations, especially those from Europe, Latin America, and the Caribbean. Modern-day Florida, from the second half of the 20th century through today, has been heavily influenced by the cultures of the people moving in from foreign countries and other parts of the United States. The State's close proximity to the Ocean influences many aspects of Florida culture and daily life. Being a part of American South, Florida has also long been influenced by the Southern culture. However, the culture in the north and central Florida does not exhibit as much of the southern culture that is found in the north and central Florida.

The Miami area especially has been culturally influenced by Latin America and Caribbean immigration. Characteristics such as a Southern accent still remain in the North Florida, Central Florida, and sparsely in Southern Florida. Florida culture is also influenced by tourism, an important industry in the State. The culture of Florida is similar to the rest of the American Southern culture in its Northern and Central subregions, particularly around the Panhandle, but as a coastal with multiple metro areas historically characterized by immigration, much of Florida's urban culture has been heavily influenced by immigration, especially from Caribbean, Latin America, and Europe.

History of Florida

The earliest traces of inhabitants of Florida date back to almost 14,000 years ago. However, it was around 500 years ago that the first known expedition to Florida was initiated which was led by a Spanish explorer, **Ponce de León**. He named the region '**La Pascua Florida**' which roughly translates to '**flowery festival**', a synonym for Easter. During the next 300 years, Florida experienced colonisation by 3 different powers of that time, France, Great Britain and Spain and also experienced large-scale immigration of natives and African – Americans. It was in the mid 19th century that Florida officially became a State of the United States. The Civil War years were tough on the State but it was not too extreme and the State continued its steady growth through agriculture and cattle-related activities. The 1920s, however, brought about a rapid decline in the growing economy of the State due to recession and the natural calamities that Florida faced further worsened the situation.

During the World War years, Florida had become a centre for the United States Armed Forces with training centres established and transportation facilities constructed to support the military of the region. After the war, these facilities were open to using by the public and the population of Florida skyrocketed. Their major economic activities shifted from agriculture-related to technology, tourism and banking. The **Sunshine State** has grown to become one of the most populous States of the US and a major contributor to the national economy with an economy so large that if it were a country, it would be among the Top 20 richest ones.

Advantages of Living in Florida

With facilities known for people of all age groups like amusement parks for kids and resorts for the retired, Florida has earned a reputation as an ideal State for living in the United States because of the following points:

1. *No income Tax:* Unlike most of the States in the US, the State of Florida exempts its citizens from paying the income tax. The Florida citizens only need to bother about federal taxes and save their income tax amount to be used for other activities. Sounds funny, right?
2. *World-class Beaches:* Florida is home to more than half of the beaches ranked as the Top 10 in the US. This means that world-class beaches await the residents of Florida just outside their doorstep. These beaches offer plenty of activities for the people to enjoy like fishing, beach volleyball, dolphin-watching cruise etc.
3. *The Convenience of Being a Local:* Amusement parks in the state attract locals as much as it attracts tourists and the locals also receive special discounts! Isn't that wonderful? Hotels and resorts offer a variety of bargains to the local customers depending on the number of tourists visiting at that time of the year and the varying seasons.
4. *Cost of Living is Comparatively Low:* Although some of the cities like Miami are quite expensive, the average cost of living in Florida is low. With most of the necessary services available at a rate below the national average and the housing rates being manageable in most cities, living in the sunshine State would certainly benefit you financially.
5. *A Diverse State:* You do not need to worry about not fitting in when you are living in Florida. ranked among the Top 10 most diverse states when measured using a standard measure of inequality, the Sunshine State is definitely a mix of all parts, Law and Public Administration of the world.

Entry Requirements

The British American University operates a flexible admission policy. Consequently, the entry requirements for admission into the BAU Bachelor's Degree programs are as follows:

- (a) **Degree Foundation Certificate Course (Enrolled Student shall be required to successfully take 50 semester units in two(2) semesters or one year):** Candidates must possess an 5 Ordinary Level GCE papers at one sitting or 6 Ordinary Level GCE papers at two(2) sittings or equivalent qualifications.
- (b) **Standard Admission into the Bachelor's degree program ((Enrolled Student shall be required to successfully take 120 semester units in three(3) years or less):** Candidate must be a holders of the British American University Degree Foundation Certificate or equivalent qualifications such as one of the following:
 - (i) American High School Diploma/Associate degree from a recognized Institution,
 - (ii) Higher School Certificate/GCE Advanced Level with passes in two(2) subjects at Principal or Advanced Level together with passes at subsidiary or O/Level credit level in three other subjects obtained at not more than two sittings;
 - (iii) Holders of the School Certificate/GCE Ordinary Level and the Higher School Certificate/GCE Advanced Level with passes in three(3) subjects at Principal or Advanced Level together with a pass in one other subject at subsidiary or O/Level credit level obtained at not more than two sittings;
 - (iv) Holders of the Higher School Certificate/GCE Advanced Level with passes in four subjects at Principal Level; or
 - (v) Holders of the School Certificate or its equivalent with at least five credit level

passes plus a recognized 2-year Diploma from a University, Research Institution or any other Institution of Higher Learning/professional body.

- (c) **Admission with transfer of 94 semester units (Enrolled Student shall be required to successfully take 76 semester units in 2 years):** In addition to the above, candidates must possess any of the following qualifications: (a) Postsecondary Diploma of the British American University, USA, International College of Management and Technology, Nigeria or their equivalent qualifications such as National Diploma (ND), NCE, 2-year Diploma from any other recognized/government approved University with a grade not below Lower Credit or recognized Associate Degrees. (b) Diploma of a recognized Professional Institute including but not limited to Chartered Institute of Administration (CIA), ICAN ATS Certificate and their equivalent qualifications such as Diploma in Journalism, Public Relations, BEEC, etc, and Passes at the Intermediate Professional Examinations of recognized Professional Institutes such as the Nigerian Institute of Public Relations (NIPR), Diploma Certificate of the Institute of Purchasing and Supply Management (NIPSM), Institute of Transport, etc.
- (d) **Admission with transfer of 60 semester units (Enrolled Student shall be required to successfully complete 110 semester units in three academic years or less):** This category of admission is only applicable to holders of degrees obtained after completion of less than 100 post secondary semester units or less than 60 semester units after National Diploma or equivalent including Higher Diploma (HD) from a recognized Institution of Higher Learning, Higher National Diploma (HND) from a Polytechnic or Final Professional Certificates of recognized Institutes such as Chartered Institute of Administration, Chartered Institute of hartered Institute of Personnel Management, Chartered Institute of Insurance, Institute of Chartered Accountants of Nigeria, Association of National Accountants of Nigeria, Chartered Institute of Bankers, and the Institute of Purchasing and Supply Management, etc. *(For enquiries as to whether your own professional body is recognized or otherwise, contact the Registrar's Office)*
- (e) **Admission with transfer of 122 semester units (Enrolled Student shall be required to successfully complete 48 semester units in an academic year):** This category of admission is applicable to holders of relevant Higher Diploma (HD) of the British American University, Florida, USA, International College of Management and Technology, Nigeria or equivalent qualifications
- (f) **Admission with per-subject credit transfer:** This category of admission is applicable to applicants who had completed certain undergraduate programs that does not lead to a degree or partially attended but not graduated from recognized undergraduate degree program provided that: (a) Subject's GPA is not less than 2 of 4 or 2.5 of 5, (b) maximum transferred credits shall not exceed 60 semester units towards graduation with a bachelor's degree from the British American University, and (c) no student shall be absorbed into the final class of any program.



The entry requirements for admission into BAU Postgraduate School are as follows:

Postgraduate Diploma: Applicants must hold a Bachelor's Degree, HND, Higher Diploma or equivalent Professional Qualifications.

Master' Degree Programs: Applicants must possess a good Bachelor's Degree with a minimum of Second Lectureroom Honors (Lower Division) from the BAU or other recognized Universities. However, Final Professional Certificates of relevant Chartered Professional Bodies such as ACIA, ACA, ACCA, ACIMA, ACIS, ACIB, CIPM, IDPM (London) ACPA (London) as well as HND with Upper Credit, Postgraduate Diploma from recognized Universities are also acceptable for the Master's degree Programs. In all cases, at least two years post qualification cognate experience is required.

Doctoral Degrees (by Course Work and Thesis): Applicants must possess a good Master's Degree with average score of 60% or better (or equivalent of 1.00 on a 4.00 GPA scale) in addition to a good Bachelor's Degree in a relevant discipline from the BAU or any other recognized University.

Doctoral Degrees (by Publications): Candidates for the Degree of PhD by Publications must be members or past members of staff/alumni of a recognized University or research Institution. In order to be eligible for consideration, alumni must be graduates of at least five years' standing and have already obtained a Masters Degree. However, in exceptional circumstances, other candidates may also be considered. Applications may be made at any time and such applications should be accompanied by:

- (i) *A list of the publications to be submitted;* these may include refereed articles, authored chapters, authored books, and edited works. They should not internally published materials or unpublished seminar/conference papers,
- (ii) *A supporting paper;* This should summarize each publication submitted, outline their interrelationships, give a critical review of the current state of knowledge and research in the applicant's field and indicate how his or her work has contributed to the field. It should also comment on the standing of any journals and the reception of the publications as indicated by citations and reviews.

Criteria for the Award of the Doctoral Degree of PhD by Publication

To be awarded a Degree of PhD by Publication of BAU, a candidate must show that his or her work makes a significant contribution to knowledge in a particular field. The publications must also provide evidence of the capacity of the candidate to pursue further research, representing a coherent contribution to research in a given field and demonstrating a depth of scholarship and originality comparable with that required in a PhD thesis. The materials submitted shall be sufficiently extensive as to provide convincing evidence that the research constitutes a substantial contribution to knowledge or scholarship, and at *Registration*, the candidate shall submit for examination:

- (a) Three copies, in published form, of each items forming part of the work on which the applications for the Degree by Publication is based. Permission to include work in manuscript, but which has been accepted for publications, may be granted upon a request by the applicant,
- (b) Four copies of the supporting papers referred to above, modified, if necessary after consultation with the adviser. A full bibliography of all the work ever published by the candidate must be included as an appendix,
- (c) A statement as to what partof the materials have been submitted for a Degree or other qualifications at BAU or any other universityexplaining the reason for its inclusion, and
- (d) If joint work is submitted, what part of it is the candidate's contribution?

In all cases, possession of a good Master's Degree from a recognized University is mandatory.

Doctoral Degrees (by Research): This option is available to advanced academic staff in the Universities or other research institutions. The basic entry requirements are as follows:

- (i) A good Bachelor Degree with a minimum of Second Lectureroom Honors (Upper Division),
- (ii) A Master Degree in relevant disciplines with average score of 60% or better (or equivalent of 1.00 on a 4.00 GPA scale)
- (iii) Must be working in a University or a research institution as a lecturer, instructor or researcher
- (iv) A minimum of 10 years work experience is mandatory,
- (v) A minimum of 10 academic and/or professional publications in relevant disciplines in the mixture of journal articles, textbooks, contributions to books, edited books, monographs, etc. is mandatory.
- (vi) Possession of Final Professional Certificate of recognized Chartered Professional Institute will be an added advantage.

Having met the above conditions, the applicant ONLY needs to write the Thesis/Dissertation on an Approved Topic relevant to his area of specialization to fulfill the requirements for the award of the Doctoral Degree. Applicants holding Master's Degrees with average score less than 60% (or GPA of 1.00 out of a 4.00 scale) who wish to enroll for the PhD may be considered for M. Phil./PhD alternative. However, irrespective of the submission by the Applicants, the decision of the BAU is final on admission, which is also dependent on availability of space. NOTE: If a candidate of PhD by Research wishes to specialize in any area of study, he/she should write his thesis in that area.

All doctoral students must take the following required courses for one or two months though may not take any semester examination on them other than class tests and/or paper presentations before they commence their PhD programs. The assessment will just be on pass or fail basis without credit points: (a) Scholarly Writing and Publications, (b) Institutional Pedagogy, and (c) Doctoral Research



English Language Requirements

If English isn't your first language, studying at the British American University, Florida, can be very challenging. That's why we make sure you have the language skills you need to succeed right from the start. We've listed our English language entry requirements here and the qualifications we accept. You can also meet your language requirements by successfully completing our Pre-sessional English course. We accept a range of English language qualifications. You'll need to achieve the required grade in one of

our accepted English language tests, such as, Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) and International English Language Test System (IELTS).

The alternative English language tests accepted by the British American University are as follows:

- (a) British American University English Language Test System (BAUELT)
- (b) British American University Certificate of Proficiency in English with overall average of 60% or better,
- (c) British American University Certificate of Advanced English with overall average of 60% or better,
- (d) British American University Certificate of Business and Industrial English with overall average of 60% or better,
- (e) British American University Entrance Test in English for Speakers of other Languages with overall average of 60% or better,
- (f) British American University International School Board Certificate of Attainment in English with overall average of 60% or better,
- (g) British American University Language Center Professional English Language Certificate with overall average of 60% or better,
- (h) British American University Language Center English for Special Purposes Certificate with overall average of 60% or better,
- (i) Ordinary Level General Certificate of Education (O/L GCE) or Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination (SSCE) issued by the West African Examinations Council (WAEC), National Examinations Council (NECO) in Nigeria with a grade not below Credit (C) OR
- (j) Ordinary Level General Certificate of Education (O/L GCE) or Senior Secondary School Certificate Examination (SSCE) issued by the National Business and Technical Examination Board (NABTEB) in Nigeria with Credit (C) or better,

Admission Processing Procedures



Application Form is obtainable by post or personally from the Office of the Registrar, British American University or any other designated offices worldwide. It may also be downloaded or completed online from the BAU website www.bau-edu.us. The processing fee as indicated on the Admission form is US\$50.00 payable by direct remittance into the University' Bank Accounts. Completed forms with credentials should be returned to the Registrar, British American University, Administrative Complex, Fola Adeoti Strre, Itele-Awori, Ogun State, Nigeria. Application forms of those who do not meet the Minimum Entry Requirements for programs of their choices may be considered for other programs at the discretion of the Registrar whose decision is final. Each Admission form should be accompanied by the following documents:

- (a) Certified True Copies of all Certificates (Academic and/or Professional).
- (b) Certified True Copies of Birth Certificate or Sworn Declaration of Age,
- (c) In case of Postgraduate Admission, original copies of all academic Transcripts,
- (d) Proof of Sponsorship in the forms of letter from a sponsor, in the case of self-sponsored candidates, a letter of guarantee from employer or any other document to show the candidates financial ability to cope with the financial needs while on the program,
- (e) Attestation/Recommendation Letter from a notable person such as a Clergyman, Imam, employer or the Principal of the candidates' former School/University.
- (f) A Letter of Understanding by the candidate to be of good conduct while on the BAU Program,
- (g) Identity Documents such as International Passport, National Identity Card or a letter of identity from the candidate's local Government of Origin,
- (h) A copy of recently taken Passport Photograph of the Candidate, and
- (i) Any other document which in the opinion of the candidate would enhance his/her chance of being admitted.

After the receipt of the Admission form with all relevant accompanying documents, the Admission Officer will review the entire package. If at any stage the attention of the candidate is required, a document is missing, the Admission Officer needs some more clarification especially in the case of postgraduate admission, the candidate will be contacted either by phone or by e-mail. A postgraduate may be invited to come and make oral presentation particularly in case of PhD applicants. Otherwise, if the Admission Officer is satisfied after the review of the package, the candidate will be admitted and the Admission/Acceptance Letter will be issued.

Transfer of Credit

All applicants are required to send evidence of prior education and/or training. Upon the receipt of supporting documents, the Admissions Officers in coordination with the related faculty staff will perform credentialing analysis and evaluation for eligibility and possible credit transfer. Successful candidates will receive an acceptance letter along with a study plan and an enrollment agreement within three business days from the date of supporting documents receipt.

Acceptance

BAU will develop a Personalized Study Plan for each applicant based on major, minor field of study and the transferred credit from previously attended study or training. If the applicant has a specific interest in a subject that is not listed in his/her suggested study plan, it is possible to coordinate with Admissions Officer regarding the required change after specification of selected subject code(s) from Degree Programs listing and the code of the replaced subject. An updated study plan will then be sent back to the student after the approval and subject replacement process.

Enrollment Agreement

An Enrollment Agreement includes degree details, fees, payment options, refund policy and a method of payment issued to each prospective student after acceptance for his/her careful review and signature. The student will retain a copy, and return the signed originals of the Enrollment Agreement and Study Plan along with the payment evidence to the University.

Student's Right to Cancel the Enrollment Agreement

A student has the right to cancel the Enrollment Agreement and obtain a refund of charges paid through non-attendance at the first class session or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.

Refund Policy

Student must submit a written, signed and dated notice of cancellation and refund to the Registrar in order to qualify for cancellation of the enrollment agreement and to a refund of excess paid value. The cancellation effective date is the date of notice submission. If the student has received federal student financial aid funds, the student is entitled to a refund of moneys not paid from the federal students financial aid program funds. Students who withdraw from the program before enrollment or within the first 7 days after enrollment will receive a 100% refund of any paid tuition and fees. If student withdraws after the first class session or after 7 business days from enrollment date, a prorated refund shall not be less than the total amount owed by the student for the portion of the educational program provided subtracted from the amount paid by the student, calculated as follows: The amount owed equals the daily charge for the program (total institutional charge, divided by the number of days or hours in the program), multiplied by the number of days student attended, or was scheduled to attend, prior to withdrawal.

All refundable amounts paid by the student in excess of what is owed as calculated above shall be refunded. Except as provided herein, all amounts that the student has paid shall be subject to refund unless the enrollment agreement and the refund policy outlined in the catalog specify amounts paid for an application fee or deposit not more than \$250.00, books, supplies, or equipment, and specify whether and under what circumstances those amounts are non-refundable. In addition to BAU's commitment to apply low cost tuition which is usually about 30% of what regularly applied at most of the for-profit postsecondary educational facilities, BAU develops customized financial-aid packages based on student's level of financial need, and the availability of allocated funds.

Every student package may include any or a combination of the following major financial aid programs including Gift aid that does not require repayment and is divided into three categories which are Grants that recognize financial need, Scholarship in recognition of academic merit and Awards, Loans, that must be repaid to lender (usually after graduation) and can come from private lenders and university sources when allocated funds are available, and Work-study allows students to earn money for University expenses while gaining valuable skills - often in their intended field. All accepted students are eligible for interest free payment plans without any banking process or credit reviews, 10% immediate discount if tuition is paid in full, and 5% if paid in full within three months from enrollment date and 10% special discount if student is a first relative of a BAU current or graduated student. Textbook recycling program manages used textbooks' collection and redistribution free of charge. This service helps a wide range of students who may face financial strains purchasing educational materials. Other forms of scholarship and financial assistance are as listed in the University catalog and website www.bau-edu.us

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE AND SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS



While British American University welcomes contributions from individuals, corporate bodies and the general public to come into the aid of the needy students through scholarships or sponsorships in one way or the other, the University in order to *help with study offers undergraduates and postgraduates a range of scholarships and studentships* for the needy students as follows:

1. University Scholarships

We offer a range of undergraduate scholarships awarded directly through our faculties and departments. Majority of these scholarships offer support towards tuition fees, although some may also contribute towards living costs. Competition for these scholarships is mainly based on academic performance and the number of scholarships and studentships offered varies from year to year. For entry in 2021-2022 session, there is US\$2million in funding opportunities available through all the Faculties and Departments. There is a wide range of funding opportunities available, but competition is fierce and you will need to begin your enquiries in good time to meet deadlines. BAU also offers postgraduate students scholarships to give the winners the opportunity to undertake research in a stimulating interdisciplinary environment within a thriving postgraduate community. These awards may be up to 50% of the tuition fees. All departments have an international reputation for excellence in research and teaching and provide homes to some of the leading names in their respective fields. However, you will need to have received an offer of admission before your application for funding can be considered as you will need to attach a copy of your acceptance letter to your application; so

have to apply for admission in good time.

2. ***Prof Muhammad Omolaja Scholarship Awards***

This is a bachelor's degree scholarship award for students admitted into undergraduate programs of the University every year for educational development particularly of the youths. This scholarship is for students who have not benefitted from other scholarship programs, and it covers 50% of tuition fees only. It does not cover other expenses associated with the degree program. The beneficiaries only need to submit a copy of their acceptance into any of the undergraduate programs of the British American University, Florida.

3. ***Dean's Award for PhD Students***

The Dean's Award for Excellence in Postgraduate Studies recognizes outstanding doctoral research in ALL Faculties. Three awards are made annually per Faculty, one each to a student in the first, second and third year of their PhD on the basis of academic merit. However, each Faculty may also use criteria like contributions of a dedicated staff to work and University development.

4. ***Master's Bursary Awards***

BAU is pleased to offer a number of Bursary Awards for outstanding overseas students wishing to study on a taught Masters level program. The value of each award will be US\$2,500 per student. These Awards will be made for one year only and are conditional on satisfactory progress during the first semester of study. These awards are administered by individual Departments. Applicants wishing to be considered for the awards should apply via the University applications process noting in the section on ***source of funding*** that they wish to be considered for a Master's **Bursary Award**. To be considered for an award, applicants **must hold an offer of a place** to study in any Department in the University by the deadline date and should be due to commence their studies immediately. Applicants may only apply for an award for a program on which they are not already registered. This award will be allocated to successful students in the form of a fee reduction.

5. ***Faculty of Management Sciences Postgraduate Scholarships and funding***

We know that undertaking a postgraduate program can be a significant financial commitment; and the BAU Faculty of Management Sciences is therefore making available over US\$1million in scholarship funds for applicants who have been offered an admission place on one of the Faculty programs for entry during the session and who meet the Faculty scholarship criteria of Second Class Honors (Upper Division) in their bachelor's degrees.

6. ***Alumni, Academic Excellence and Program Scholarships***

BAU offers **Alumni Scholarships** for graduates from BAU, and in addition we have **Academic Excellence** and **Program Scholarships** for international applicants who fit other merit-based criteria. You can find further details on the individual program scholarships. The scholarship amounts will vary and are typically awarded in the amounts of 25%, but can be up to 50% of the tuition fees. These generous scholarships are provided for self-funded and part-funded applicants and are awarded on a rolling basis for as long as the funds are available. However, there is a huge demand for places on all of our postgraduate programs and so we would encourage you to make your application for your chosen program as soon as possible. Students on the scholarship award may be asked to act as student ambassadors on their programs.

7. ***Funded PhD Opportunities***

BAU is pleased to offer a number of studentships for PhD students. These awards will ensure that outstanding candidates have access to the University's high-quality research training and

facilities, and experienced research-active supervisors. At BAU, postgraduate research funding is available across all faculties and it may be up to 50% of the tuition fees.

8. Graduate Assistantship Awards

Applicants for this award must be a postgraduate student with B.Sc., BA or BSc(Ed.) with a minimum of *Second Class Honors (Upper Division)*. The winner may be requested to teach some courses at the undergraduate level. The award may be up to 50% of the tuition fees.

9. Teaching Assistantship Awards

Applicants for this award must be a holder of Associate Degrees, ND, NCE, Advanced Level GCE, University Diploma or an equivalent professional qualification with a minimum of *Upper Credit* status. The winner may be requested to teach some subjects at the *British American University International School*. The award may be up to 50% of the tuition fees.

10. Discount for payment of Tuition Fees in Full

There is automatic discount of 15% reduction in tuition fees for students that make prompt payment of their tuition fees in full every session.

11. Discount for Prompt Registration in a Department

There is automatic discount of 15% reduction in tuition fees for the first 10 students to register in a Department every session.

12. Nuclear Family Awards

This Award is only available to applicants of the same nuclear family of at least two(2) members under the University programs. In such a case, one of the members may receive up to 25% waiver of the tuition fee.

13. Financial Assistance to the nuclear families of BAU Staff members

BAU staff members are entitled to 50% reduction in tuition fees. This Award is only available to nuclear family members of the staff, and it does not cover other expenses.

BAU LANGUAGE AND MATHEMATICS CENTER

The BAU Language and Mathematics Center (LMC) has been designed and established to take care of potential students who may need to undergo a thorough grounding in a Language course such as English, Fench, Yoruba, German, Spanish, Russian, Italian and Portuguese or those who are defective in one way or the other in Mathematics so that they can be brought up to the level at which they can cope with the specific needs of their chosen course of study in the University. This kind of participants will also be prepared by the Center to meet the requirements of their career practices upon their successful graduation from the University. The other aspect of the Center is to run the Intensive English and Academic English for the University Undergraduate and Postgraduate students as may be required.



Undergraduates

Intensive English Program

The intensive English program for undergraduates offers English ENG001- Intermediate English, and English ENG002 - Advanced English. Students are placed in one of the two levels according to their scores on the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) or Test of English as a Foreign Language Internet-Based Test (TOEFL-iBT) if they are not holding any of the BAU Language and Mathematics Center Certificates in English. Undergraduate students in the Intensive English Program (IEP) are allowed to take up to a full calendar year to reach the freshman English level (ENGL100). For example, students entering the IEP in the spring who do not reach the freshman English level by the end of that semester may attend the summer session and the following fall semester (2nd Semester). If at the end of one calendar year a student still has not attained the required freshman level, he/she will be suspended.

Content of Courses

Students are placed in sections normally comprised of up to seventeen students, according to levels of proficiency. Students are given a grammar review, extensive reading and writing practice, advanced vocabulary review, instruction in study skills, and practice in speaking and listening comprehension. Integration among these skill areas is stressed at all levels. Grading in this course is on a Pass or Fail system.

Attendance

Attendance and participation are considered so important to this intensive language program that a student who for any reason misses the equivalent of six days of class (thirty hours) in any one semester will be asked to withdraw. Students who are asked to withdraw but fail to do so will be suspended. A committee of IEP Administrators and Instructors will decide whether or not the suspended student will be allowed to return to the program.

Readmission

Suspended students who are not allowed to return to the IEP may be readmitted to BAU only if they submit new iBT, IELTS scores or any of the English based Certificate from the BAU Language and Mathematics Center placing them in levels higher than the IEP. Other applicants for readmission may not submit a new TOEFL iBT or IELTS score unless more than six months have elapsed since their last TOEFL iBT or IELTS examination or the IEP exit battery.

Academic English for Freshmen (ENG100)

Academic English for Freshmen (ENG100) is a non-credit, concurrent, conference-centered course in which classes meet four days a week for a total of 12 (in-class) instructional hours, in addition to weekly conferences with the teacher. A student who for any reason misses 10 days will be dropped from the course. A student who is dropped will be allowed to retake the course the following semester. Sessions are devoted to the comprehension and summary of University-level texts, the

introduction to basic research tools, the writing of essays on science and humanities topics and remedial grammar, within the context of individual teacher- student conferences. Freshmen taking ENG 100 may enroll in no more than six academic courses with a maximum of 18 academic course credits. Any student who withdraws from ENG100 must also withdraw from the six other academic courses.

For new students, placement in ENG100 is determined by their score on the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) or Test of English as a Foreign Language Internet-Based Test (TOEFL-iBT). For students enrolled in the Intensive English Program (IEP), placement in Academic English for freshmen is determined by their score on the IEP exit test. All students who have been admitted into ENG100 must satisfactorily complete the course work within a time period not to exceed two full semesters and a summer session. Students taking ENG100 in summer may also enroll for other academic course.

Graduate Programs

Graduate students who are otherwise qualified to enter the University but whose English does not meet the necessary level of proficiency, based on the applicant's performance on the TOEFL iBT or IELTS, will be admitted to ENG102. Graduate students in the intensive English courses are allowed a maximum of one semester to reach the level of Academic English for Graduates.

Intensive English for Graduates

The intensive English program for graduate students offers ENG 120 (Intermediate) and ENG121 (Advanced). Students are placed in one of the two levels according to their scores on the TOEFL iBT or IELTS. Students in these courses are allowed to concurrently enroll for a maximum of six other courses.

Content of Courses

Students are placed in sections normally composed of up to twelve students. Students are given a grammar review, extensive reading and writing practice, advanced vocabulary review, and practice in speaking and listening comprehension. Grading in this course is on a Pass or Fail system.

Attendance

Attendance and participation are considered so important to this intensive language program that a student who for any reason misses the equivalent of more than 21 class hours will be asked to withdraw. Applicants for readmission may submit an iBT TOEFL or IELTS score. Alternatively, a Certificate in English from the BAU Language and Mathematics Center is enough. Students who are asked to withdraw but fail to do so will be suspended.

Suspension and Readmission

Graduate students suspended from ENG120 or 121 must apply for readmission and must meet all the admission requirements prevailing at the time of readmission. Readmission is not granted

automatically. Students suspended from ENG120 or 121 who are readmitted to the University must score high enough on the TOEFL iBT or the IELTS for direct admission to Academic English for Graduates or higher, as they will not be allowed to return to ENG120 or 121.

Academic English for Graduates

Academic English for graduate students consists of three non-credit modules covering effective writing (ENG123, academic reading (ENG124), listening and speaking (ENG125). Students who are taking all their required modules may take other courses at the same time, thus enabling them to apply what they are learning in these modules to what they will be expected to do in other graduate courses. Grading in these modules is on a Pass/Fail system. ENG123 meets for two hours two times a week, while the other two modules (ENG124 and 125) meet for two hours one time per week. Students enrolled in any of the modules are expected to spend at least three hours per week outside of class in preparation for each weekly class meeting of each module in which they are enrolled (e.g., a student enrolled in three modules should expect to spend at least 9 hours per week outside class plus eight hours per week in class.

MISSION STATEMENT OF THE FACULTY

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CENTER FOR PROFESSIONAL TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT

WELCOME TO CENTER FOR TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT

The Professional Training and Development Programs (PTDP) at the British American University, Florida, is the arm of the University where various professional programs and foundation/preparatory education are run for various categories of students. Included in the under the PTDP are the following:

- (a) Center for Training and Development,
- (b) International Institute of Human Rights Studies,
- (c) Center for Women Education and Development,
- (d) Center for Transport Management, and
- (e) Center for Alternative Medicine,
- (f) Center for Degree Foundation Programs, and
- (g) Language and Mathematics Center.

CENTER FOR TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT

As an American Registered University, British American University operates a **Center for Training and Development** which runs professional training programs leading to the award of postsecondary professional qualifications such *Certificate, Diploma and Higher Diploma qualifications*. Upon the successful completion of the programs, students will collect the following Diploma Certificates:

- (a) *Certificate program*; this is a short term course of 1 to 6 months duration offered to professional students in need of a Certificate in their respective fields to upgrade their professional knowledge and competency at work. The specific focus of the training includes computer/ICT training, entrepreneurship training, youths and women empowerment training, Human Resource Management, and so on,
- (b) *Diploma program*; this is of longer term duration ranging from 1 year to 2 years depending on the course contents. The 2 years Diploma programs are equivalents of Associate Degrees from American Colleges or Universities, and they may be used for employment or direct entry admission into the 2nd year of a relevant Bachelor's degree program, and
- (c) *Higher Diploma program*; this is a professional Higher Diploma for candidates who have already gotten the Diploma or its equivalent, and have finished the mandatory 1 year **Industrial Attachments**. The program is of 2 years duration, and it is an equivalent of Bachelor's degree from an American Institution. Holders of the Higher Diploma are qualified for direct admission into the Master's programs.

Programs Available

At the Certificate level, the BAU Center for Training and Development runs Certificate in Entrepreneurship, Human Resource Management, Youths and Women Empowerment, Computer and ICT training, Competency in Agriculture, etc. For the postsecondary Diploma and professional Higher Diploma, the Center runs various programs in the Faculties of Management Sciences, Social Sciences, Arts, Law and Criminology, Education as well as Science, Engineering and Technology. Invariably, all the Bachelor's degrees listed in these Faculties are also run at the Diploma and Higher Diploma levels at the BAU Center for Training and Development.

Entry Requirements

The entry requirement for the Certificate program is a High School Diploma from an American School or Ordinary Level General Certificate of Education (O/L GCE). For entry into the Diploma program, candidates must have at least O/L GCE 4 Credit passes. Finally, for the Higher Diploma, candidates must have a minimum of 4 O/L GCE Credit papers in addition to the 2 years postsecondary Diploma or equivalent professional qualification. In all cases, a proof of competency in English Language is required, and for Diploma and Higher Diploma programs, candidates also need a proof of competency in Mathematics.
